Mr. Charles Keith Kirkland, 62, of Hartwell, passed away Friday, July 12, 2019 in Seneca, SC.

Born on September 30, 1956 in Atlanta, GA, he was the son of the late Charles G. Kirkland and Betty Davis Kirkland. Mr. Kirkland was retired from BellSouth (AT&T) having worked for thirty years and a farmer, working in the poultry industry. He was a member of the First Baptist Church of Hartwell.
