



## Bro. Olen Miller

March 22, 1927 - April 11, 2020

Bro. Olen M. Miller, 93, was called from this life to be with his Lord. He died peacefully in his sleep on April 11, 2020, at his residence at 442 Sunnybrook Lane, Hartwell, GA surrounded by his family after a six-month illness.

He was born to Moses J. and Maude E. Hochstetler Miller on March 22, 1927 in Nappanee, IN. He was married to Katie M. Yoder on November 4, 1948, his beloved companion of 71 years who survives.
